We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

Phase 1 of the development will provide:

- 99 two, three and four bedroom, detached and semi-detached homes
- Open market 38 home
 Affordable rent 23 homes
 Shared ownership 35 homes
 Social rent 3 homes
- Each home will have solar panels and an electric vehicle charging point

Specific items

Pump Station live and all works completed. Substation live.

Spine road through site now open to the public.

Site activity

Current site activity


- Works to the S278 roundabout complete with final remedials ongoing.
- S278 Nedge Lane Majority of works complete for the pedestrianisation of Nedge Lane. Part of lane currently closed to vehicles with the eastern section likely to be fully pedestrianised by Christmas 2025 following installation of the final signs and bollards. The final surfacing treatment to Nedge Lane will be completed in Spring 2026.
- Footpath/cycleway connecting site to Nedge Lane complete and open to the public.
- S104 approved and to be adopted by LEEP
- S38 designs approved and will be adopted by Telford and Wrekin Highways.

Next stages

- Build continues across both the Western and Eastern parcels, with the first plots on the Eastern parcel due to be occupied Q1 2026.
- Show home opening on the Eastern parcel Q1 2026.
